**FILING OF 2014 ANNUAL STATEMENTS** 

Relative to the filing of the 2014 Annual Statement, the following guidelines shall be implemented:

- 1. Enclosed as Annex "A" is the updated list of the required documents and other schedules which shall form part as separate attachment in the submission of the Annual Statements.
- 2. Enclosed as Annex "B" is the revised Table of Contents of the Annual Statement showing the Summary of Investment for the year ended December 31, 2014 and Certification, Notarized and Sealed on pages 48 and 49, respectively.
- 3. The Seriatim List of In-force policies and List of Availing Plan for the Succeeding Year (Exhibit 6 and 7 respectively) shall be filled in summary form in the Annual Statement and the details/breakdown shall be submitted in soft copies (CD or USB).
- 4. The exact formats, columnar headings and footnote instructions found in every page of the prescribed Annual Statement (two (2) copies) including the Annual Statements of Trust Fund (one (1) copy each) for each type of plans shall be strictly observed.

All companies are hereby reminded to file the Annual Statements not later than 30 April 2015 to avoid penalty.

The filing fees is P 25,000.00 plus P250.00 representing Legal Research Fund (LRF) with a penalty for late filing of P 5,000 for each day of delay.

 a. Annual Pre-need Reserve Valuation Report, together with:
<ol> <li>Certification by the actuary and/or any accountable officer of the company on the accuracy and completeness of the in-force files used in the valuation of reserves, and</li> <li>Certification on the prudent adequacy of the Pre-need reserve that it shall provide at least the guaranteed contractual benefits under each pre-need contract of the company,</li> <li>List of current members of board of directors and officers, their respective addresses, positions and committee membership,</li> </ol>
c. Minutes of meetings of the board and executive committees, including board resolutions made during the year;
d. Soft copies of the Annual Statements and all its schedules including Annual Statements of trust funds per type of plan;
 e. Soft copies of supporting details of Exhibit 6 & Exhibit 7
f. Sworn Statement from the responsible officers of the company stating that.ff
Any deficiency in the Trust Funds has been duly addressed, attaching all the necessary documents as proofs thereof.

Sworn Statement from the company's Insurer, certifying the coverage on life insurance policies or guarantees on premium payments assumed by the insurance company, indicating the extent, term and duration of such coverage/guarantees;</li> <li>h.
