SUBJECT : IC Circular Letter No. 2021-02

Dear Mr. Garcia:

This is in reference to your letter dated 02 February 2021 imploring the Commission to issue a clarificatory letter on the guidelines for the declaration and/or distribution of dividends as provided for under IC Circular Letter No. 2021-02 dated 07 January 2021 as it relates to Insurance Brokers.

Please be advised that the Commission confirms the following:

- 1. That, Circular Letter 2021-02 is not intended to restrict or prohibit Insurance Brokers from declaring dividends but rather, the Circular only serves as a regulatory measure;
- 2. That, the phrase "sum sufficient to pay all losses" does not cover brokers as it finds relevance only to insurance companies; and
- 3. That, the phrase "all liabilities" only refers to those items that falls within the business of a broker such as taxes and other outstanding liabilities.

Further, please be advised that the circular was only promulgated to impose appropriate safeguards on the monitoring of the financial well-being of all IC-regulated entities and is not intended to hamper the operations of any member of the industry.
