IC COMMISSIONER DOOC INITIATES SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAMS IN DAET

Insurance Commissioner Emmanuel F. DooC initiated two (2) school building programs in Daet, Camarines Norte.

Through the efforts of Commissioner DooC, Cocolife Insurance and Philam Life Insurance Company donated a science laboratory building to Camarines Norte

National High School and a new classroom building to Daet Elementary School, respectively.

The P1.9 science laboratory building donated by Cocolife Insurance is the first ever science laboratory in the Camarines Norte National High School. Speaking at the turn over ceremony last May 19, 2015, which was attended by Cocolife President Alfredo C. Tumacder, Jr. and Senior Vice President Artemio A. Tanchoco, Jr. as well as the school administrators and teachers of the national high school, Commissioner Dooc lauded Cocolife Insurance for its commitment of giving quality education and holistic development of the students as part of its corporate social responsibility.
