SUSPENSION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW

TEMPLATE FOR MOTOR CAR INSURANCE POLICY FORM

WHEREAS, on 19 May 2022, the Insurance Commission (Commission) promulgated Insurance Memorandum Circular (IMC) No. 2022-02, entitled, "Adoption of New Template for Motor Car Policy Forms."

WHEREAS, the IMC No. 2022-02 required all non-life insurance companies to revise its existing motor car insurance policy form/s by adopting the new templates attached therein;

WHEREAS, in view of LTO Memorandum Circular No, 2020-2227 dated 20 November 2020 and LTO Administrative Order No. 2021- 039 dated 11 May 2021 concerning electric vehicles, there is a need to further study and review the insurance coverages, policy wordings and applicable premium rates for electric vehicles and its vehicle classifications and operations under said issuances;

WHEREAS, the further study and review of policy forms opens an opportunity to simplify and reduce the present policy forms from eight (8) to two (2);

NOW, **THEREFORE**, pursuant to the powers vested in me by Section 437 of the Insurance Code, as amended by Republic Act No. 10607, the undersigned hereby resolves to **SUSPEND**, until further notice, the implementation of new templates for motor car insurance policy under IMC No. 2022-02.

The suspension is without prejudice to the policy forms already adopting the new templates.

This Circular shall takes effect immediately.
