The objective is to require all Insurance Commission Regulated Entities (ICREs) to conduct a screening and scrubbing against their respective database and determine whether the corporations mentioned in the notices are one of ICREs' existing customers.

Once determined, if any, the ICREs should conduct appropriate Customer Due Diligence (CDD) and transaction monitoring and require such customers, if applicable, the submission of General Information Sheet as part of their ongoing CDD process under rule 18 of the 2018 Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the AMLA, as amended and section 5 of IC CL No. 2019-65.
