

PROCLAMATION NO. 11

Series of 2023

DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND THE SUSPENSION OF WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN DAVAO CITY ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2023 DUE TO TROPICAL STORM "KABAYAN"

WHEREAS, the Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (DOST-PAGASA) issued Tropical Cyclone Bulletin Number 7, at 11:00 PM of December 17, 2023, which states that Tropical Depression "Kabayan" (Jelawat) has intensified into a Tropical Storm, with the center estimated at 275 kms East of Davao City, and moving West Northwestward at 15km/h at maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, with strong to gale-force winds expected to extend outwards up to 420 km from the center;

WHEREAS, said bulletin places Davao City under Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) No. 1 with strong winds at speeds of 39 to 61km/h, and with heavy rainfall outlook in neighboring areas, wherein the forecast rainfall is expected to be generally higher in elevated or mountainous areas, and flooding and rain-induced landslides to be likely in areas susceptible to such hazards;

WHEREAS, said bulletin includes the issuance of a Gale Warning for the coastal waters along the eastern seaboards of Visayas and Mindanao, with mariners of small seacraft (including all motor bancas of any type of tonnage) advised to remain in port or seek safe harbor;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Davao is duty-bound to safeguard the welfare of the public and undertake measures to avert any untoward incidents or disasters that may be caused by the effects of said weather occurrence;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **SEBASTIAN Z. DUTERTE**, Mayor of the City of Davao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the following to take effect on **Monday**, **December 18**, **2023**:

- That classes and school activities in ALL LEVELS in all public and private educational institutions in Davao City are hereby suspended;
- That work in all national and local government offices, including governmentowned and controlled corporations in Davao City, EXCEPT for offices performing safety and security, health, social services and disaster and emergency response services, are hereby suspended;
- That private offices and establishments are given the discretion to suspend work or adopt WFH arrangements, but are encouraged to do so for the safety and convenience of their employees.
