#### a. Logistics and Delivery:

Organize and manage the logistics for the safe and timely delivery of all components to Insurance Commission at 1071 United Nations Avenue, Ermita, Manila.

#### b. Installation and Integration:

Engage technicians for the professional installation and integration of the sound system components. Ensure optimal placement of speakers, appropriate wiring, and seamless integration with existing audio-visual equipment.

#### c. Testing and Calibration:

Conduct thorough testing of the entire sound system to ensure functionality, clarity, and balance. Calibrate the system for optimal performance in various spaces, considering acoustics and room dynamics.

#### d. User Training:

Provide training sessions for IC-ITD employees on the operation and maintenance of the newly installed sound system. Ensure that users are proficient in using the system to maximize its capabilities.

#### e. Documentation:

Prepare comprehensive documentation, including system manuals, technical specifications, and warranty information. Provide this documentation to the Insurance Commission for future reference and operation.

- f. Post-Installation Support and Warranty Coverage: Provide a specified period of post-installation support for One (1) Year to address any issues, concerns, or adjustments needed after the initial setup. This support may include troubleshooting, software updates, or additional training if required.
- 1. Prospective bidders shall bid for all the items mentioned above.
