## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commission has placed **Caritas Financial Plans, Inc. (CFPI)** under Receivership pursuant to Section 50 of Republic Act No. 9829, otherwise known as the *Pre-Need Code of the Philippines* **effective 25 April 2024.** Atty. Jose A. Barcelon was designated as Receiver for the company.

The Commission issued a Notice of Stay Order <u>effective 25 April 2024</u> against CFPI in order to consolidate, preserve, and protect the assets of the company for the benefit of the planholders and creditors while undergoing receivership proceedings.

The Commission also issued a **Directive** to set the rules and parameters in the payment of the pending obligations of CFPI while undergoing receivership proceedings.
