The amount collected by the IC from fees, charges, penalties, and other income from the regulation of insurance companies and other supervised persons or entities shall be deposited and maintained in a separate account to be used for the salary, allowances, and other expenses of the IC, pursuant to Sections 437 (n) and 441 of R.A. No. 10607.

The implementation of this provision shall be in accordance with the quidelines issued jointly by DBM and IC.
